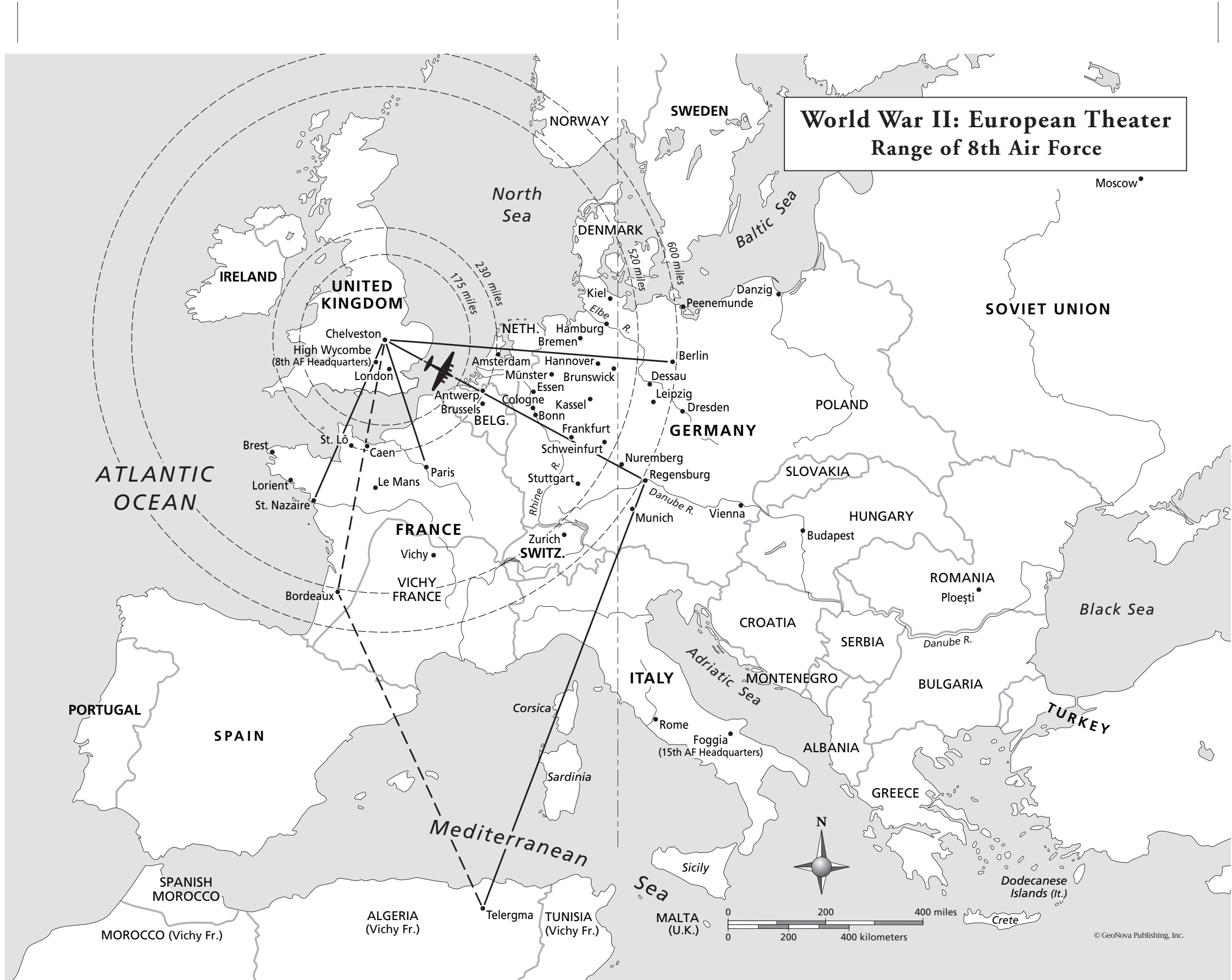

 Could you help with this?

If the rings are in nautical miles, should the scale bar be also?

Second Proof
 Scale bar changed to miles and kilometers
 Rings in statute miles
 Talerghma moved closer to Constantine, at Telerghma
 BGN doesn't list Talerghma as a "variant" for Telerghma, but it does indicate an airfield there.
 Ploesti is commonly found on WW II maps
 Current spelling is usually Ploiești

 Do the dashed lines from Telerghma to Bordeaux to Chelveston need arrowheads?
